Session Title: Joshua and Caleb

Bible Passage: Numbers 13–14

Story Point: Joshua and Caleb trusted God to give His people the promised land.

Key Passage: Proverbs 3:5-6

Key passage activity (5 minutes)

Key Passage Poster

Work with your kids to develop hand motions that can help them remember the key passage. Consider researching some simple sign language signs to use or adapt into your group's motions. Then, say the verses multiple times using the hand motions.

Say • Our key passage reminds us that we need to trust God. He knows better than we do about everything! This passage warns us against trusting our own understanding. God leads us to righteousness in Jesus. Trusting in ourselves for righteousness is sin. We saw this clearly in our story today. Joshua and Caleb trusted God, but the other 10 scouts trusted in their own understanding.
